THE BASICS

Super Emitter Program is included in NSPS 0000, 0000a, 0000b, and EG 0000c



Defines a super-emitter event as an emission event above 100 kg/hr that is:

Quantified using EPA-approved remote detection methods

Provided to EPA via notification from an EPAapproved third-party notifier Reviewed for completeness and erroneous data by EPA



Following notification from EPA, the owner/operator must:

Investigate the source of the emissions

Report specific information to EPA

Mitigate the emissions where applicable (for sources subject to requirements in the above rules)

CURRENT STATUS (OCTOBER 2024)

No third parties have applied to be notifiers

One application for alternative test methods has been submitted for use in the super emitter program

No notifications have been sent by EPA through the super emitter program
